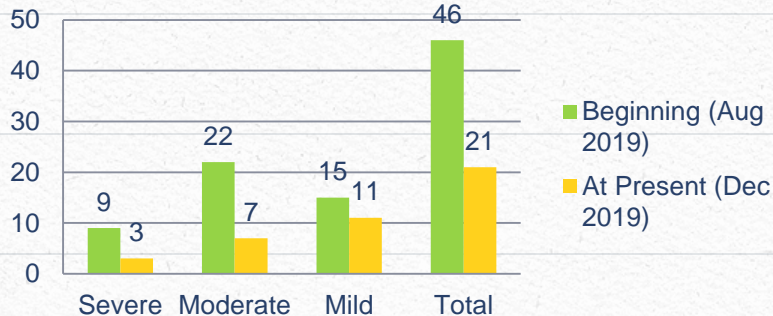
Investing in Early Years - in Hyderabad



Working with children in 15 Anganwadi centers

- Impacted 234 pregnant women, 72 babies (0-6 months), 436 infants and 134 preschoolers
- 34% reduction in malnourishment for children aged 0-3 years and 54% reduction for children aged 3-6 years with 95% mothers feeding balmrutham to their children everyday
- Facelift of 5 AWCs with painting and installation of blackboards to enable the children to doodle and express themselves
- Conducted anthropometric measurements, Nutrition Awareness camps, ALMSC (Anganwadi Level Monitoring and Support Committee) and ECCE (Early Childhood Care Education) meetings every month to raise awareness about the importance of nutrition, non-formal education and the functioning of AWCs.
- Supported by United Ways Hyderabad?

Smart classrooms

- Students understand the concepts better when the lessons are followed by audio-visual aids and experiments.
- Smart classes set up in 365+ schools across 3 states with laptops, projectors, smart TVs screens and speakers.
- Digital resources have been created and 400 lesson plans are made available to teachers in the form of Microsoft PowerPoint- to facilitate customization by teachers. All MDLS teaching resources are open source and free.
- Most of the students reported increased affinity towards experimentation and practical knowledge.
- We have signed MoU with DSERT and provided ILP digital resources to 2500+ TALP schools (Smart schools sponsored by Education Department)

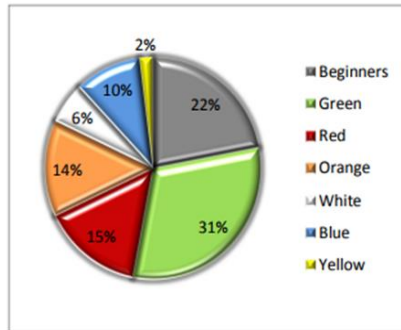
Child Friendly Reading Space

- ILP continues to source from publishers such as Tulika, CBT, NBT, Pratham, who provide books that excite children and kindle their interest and imagination.

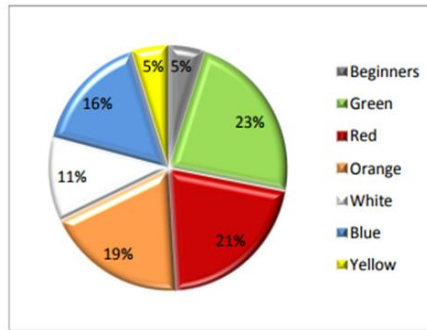
Dash Board Analysis – Sample data of RLA

Results of Library initiative - Moving Reading Levels:

- In 2019-20 we have revamped 35+ schools have been revamped across 3 states.
- Reading Level Assessment (RLA) is being taken up for both English and state languages to gauge children's progress and support them improve.
- In 2020-21 we have plan to setup 100 more school libraries in ILP working schools.
- CSR and Foundations continue to support Libraries to build language skills and also promote joy of reading!

Libraries – RLA in 3 Mandals of Hyd.

- ❖ Assessment from July to Dec 2019. All 3 Mandals have registered over 50% progress from Green to Red – moving one level up in reading in 6 months
- ❖ 66 children from all 3 Mandals have succeeded in reaching the advanced Yellow level in six months with Khairatabadh having maximum of 50 students.
- ❖ Only around 20 to 25% children are able to move to the second and third level (Red and Orange) by end of six months with Nampally showing better performance.
- ❖ This trend highlights the need for continued reading exposure to help children read better and gain fluency that would help them in reading subject content. This is one of the primary reason for children's failure on core subjects owing to inability to read and comprehend.

- We have created over 85 science experiment videos in English and translation work to Kannada is underway in collaboration with DSERT, Govt. of Karnataka.

- Comprehensive kit for Career Guidance developed by ILP that comprises of: A Career Chart mapping courses, vocations, duration etc., a Career Planner with detailed information of various courses & requirements, and a Booklet on Holland Score for determining individual aptitude & interest.
- Career Planner is available in 7 languages
- Career Guidance is rolled out in 3 Phases: 1. Orientation on the Career Chart 2. Administration of Holland Score Card (Psychometric test) to help students identify their aptitude and interests for careers and 3. The one-on-one Counselling further to obtaining results. (This has not been done owing to the Covid 19 Lockdown).

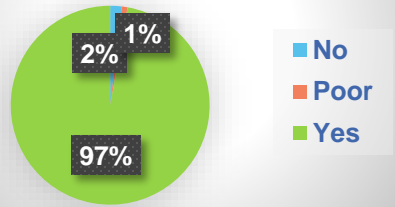
Science Magic!

- The goal of organizing Science events is to get every child to participate and demonstrate to their school mates and teachers at least one concept through the experiments without the pressure of competing or being judged!
- ILP has conducted Science Expo as part of National Science Day across chapters, in 376 schools and 11000+ Projects/experiments conducted through nearly 15,400 students covering 5 taluks in Karnataka and 9 Mandals in Hyderabad.

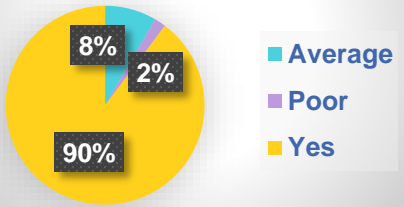

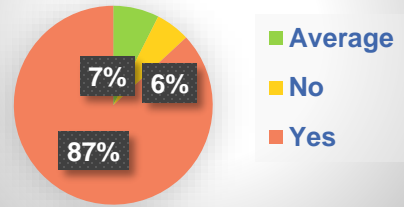

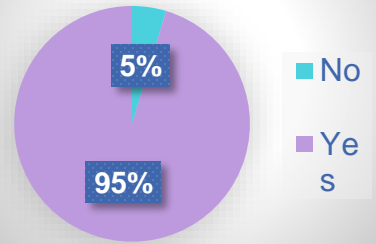

MDLS-Strengthening Teacher Capacity

- Teacher capacity building is central to the transformation of classroom engagement and to increase learning outcomes. ILP invests extensively in technical support as part of the MDLS program.
- The Training focuses on the use of digital content for teaching, the GROW BY approach for libraries, accessing Google earth for social science education, Science experiments for children and conducting career guidance sessions.
- 2019 has set the tone for District level teacher training in Karnataka on the request of the Education department with potential to take to scale. Commenced in the 3 districts of Raichur, Tumkur and Madhugiri. 1515 supervising officials and teachers have been part of the process.
- On the invitation of the Government of Tamil Nadu ILP and partner NGO IRCDS facilitated a unique two-day workshop 'Nishtha' for school teachers on 'Teacher Motivation'. The interactive sessions elicited excited participation from the ... teachers present.
- **Science Kit:** We have updated our Science kit and added many new experiments in new edition. Part of our program we provide training too and trained 550+ teachers on how to use this kit in classrooms & difficult concepts with demos and hands-on.
- **Career Guidance:** For the first ever under the Integrated Child Protection Scheme, ILP trained 190 Counsellors and Superintendents of 86 Child Care Institutions and all 30 District Child Protection Units of the Karnataka in order to reach out to the most vulnerable children residing in the child care homes.

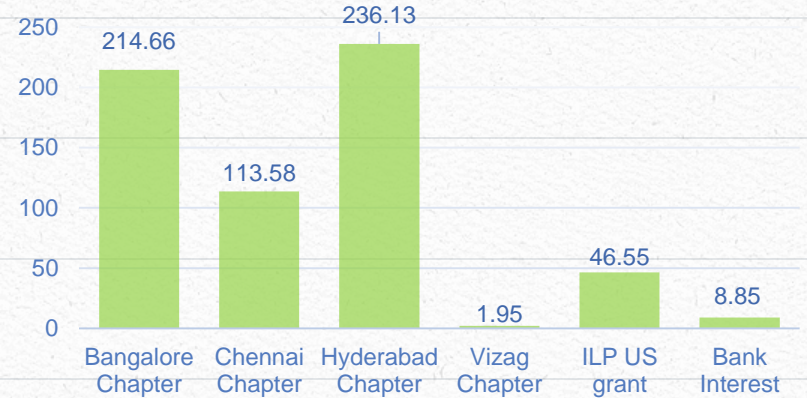
